CLEARANCE PROCEDURE FOR MEDICAMENTS.

Reference:

A: T&T/2019 CIRCULAR NO.03 dated 4 March, 2019

B: T&T/2019 CIRCULAR NO.04 dated 14 March, 2019

1. I am directed to refer to the above subject matter and to convey that the content of the above mentioned circulars are still extant.

2. For the avoidance of doubts, all shipments of medicaments cannot be transferred to Bonded Terminals under whatever guise, but must be processed and released in the mother ports.

3. Consequently, importation of medicaments into the Country is still restricted to the under listed entry points:

- i. Apapa Port, Lagos.
- ii. Calabar Port.
- iii. Murtala Mohammed Int'l Airport, Lagos.
- iv. Mallam Aminu Kano Int'l Airport, Kano.
- v. Port-Harcourt Airport, Port-Harcourt.
- vi. Nnamdi Azikiwe Airport, Abuja.
