DAILY SUMMARY ALERT

ALERTS DATE

The following section illustrates the date alerts were reported on Tuesday, 18th October, 2022.

BANDITRY

- Two people were reportedly killed by armed gunmen at the Abdulsalam Abubakar General Hospital in Gulu, Lapai Local Government Area, Niger State. They also kidnapped over ten people, including a hospital doctor and a pharmacist. According to reports, the incident occurred on Tuesday, around 2 a.m. It was learnt that the bandits stormed the hospital in large numbers, shooting sporadically throughout their operation with no intervention from security personnel or local vigilantes.
- On Monday night, gunmen suspected of being bandits brutally murdered three people, including the village head Nyalung of Plateau State's Wase Local Government Area. According to reports, the bandits stormed the village around 8:30 p.m., killing the traditional ruler and kidnapping five members of the community.

KIDNAPPING

- The last three farmers who were kidnapped in Iseyin, Oyo State, recently have been freed. Four farmers were reportedly kidnapped at a farm settlement two weeks ago, and one of the farmers was murdered by the kidnapers. According to reports, the remaining three farmers were freed after the families allegedly paid N10 million. On Monday, information came to light that the ransom was paid to the captors via their authorized network in order to prevent any additional casualties.
- Kidnappers in Adamawa State killed the village head and a relative sent to deliver the ransom for his release. The kidnappers first kidnapped the village head of Bengo in the Fufore Local Government Area and demanded a ransom, which was paid by a relative, a lecturer at the Federal College of Education (FCE) Yola. After collecting the N2 million, the kidnappers not only kept the village head, but also held back the lecturer and demanded additional ransom. According to a family source, the kidnappers demanded more money, which they struggled to raise and send to the kidnappers after several assurances that they would be released. Unfortunately, they discovered their decomposing remains at the foot of the Bagale hills on Sunday evening, according to a family source.
- In Anambra State, a priest from the Catholic Archdiocese of Onitsha has been kidnapped. The Reverend Father, Parish Priest in Charge of St Joseph's Parish Abata Nsugbe, Anambra East Local Government Area of the state, was abducted on Wednesday October 12, 2022 while returning to his house after celebrating a Funeral Vigil Mass at Umunnachi in the state's Njikoka Council area.
- A former member of the Anambra State House of Assembly has been kidnapped by gunmen. The victim was abducted in Nkwelle, a community in the state's Awka South Local Government Area. According to reports, he was kidnapped on Thursday, near a military checkpoint on Awka/Nibo Road, off Ring Road. At around 6 p.m. the gunmen allegedly attacked the former lawmaker and another unidentified person along the way.

KIDNAPPING

- Six suspected kidnapers dressed in army uniforms and armed with lethal weapons are said to have abducted three children in Aseyori community, Alagbado area of Ilorin West Local Government Area, Kwara State. According to reports, the suspected hoodlums attacked the residence of a man in the area, a scrap metal dealer, last Wednesday in the area. According to reports, the incident caused panic among residents, with people fleeing for their lives, while three young boys of the businessman were later discovered to have been kidnapped by the attackers.




