### **ALERTS DATE**

The following section illustrates the date alerts were reported on Monday, 3rd October, 2022.

### **BANDITRY**

- The Zamfara State Police Command has apprehended some bandits suspected of being behind the state's banditry activities. According to the State Commissioner of Police, the Command's tenacity is yielding positive results in the ongoing fight against banditry, kidnapping, and other related crimes in Zamfara State. He stated that some of the arrested suspects were trailed to a filling station where they were arrested for allegedly supplying fuel to bandits operating in the Dumburum forest of the Zurmi Local Government Area of the State.

### **CULTISM ATTACK**

- According to the Lagos State Police Command, two suspected cultists were arrested in the Badagry area of the state for allegedly possessing a gun and substances suspected to be Indian hemp. In a statement issued on Sunday, the state Police Public Relations Officer stated that the suspects were apprehended while on routine patrol in the Ajara community, and that an investigation revealed that they were members of the Eiye cult.

### **FLOODING**

- No fewer than four people were confirmed dead after a heavy downpour in Ilorin, the capital of Kwara State, over the weekend. Property worth millions of naira was also destroyed by flooding caused by a 10-hour downpour. According to investigations, two bodies were recovered from a river near the Olusola Saraki abattoir on Sobi road by men from the state Fire Service. It was also reported that two lives were lost when youths drowned while swimming in the Asa River in the Amilengbe area, behind Salem House in Ilorin.

### **KIDNAPPING**

- An Akure High Court sentenced four people to life in prison for kidnapping a traditional leader in Ondo State in 2015. The four defendants were found guilty and sentenced to life in prison by the judge. He sentenced them to five years in prison with hard labor on count one of bothering on conspiracy to commit felony.
- In Warri, Delta State, a tricycle rider who regularly picked up two kids from and dropped them off at school has vanished. About three days ago, he picked the kids up from school; since then, the kids have vanished, and his phones have been turned off. He was a trusted individual who once drove a woman's two children to school. However, he has since left the residence where he once resided, and no one is aware of his current whereabouts.
- Unknown gunmen are said to have killed a store owner at Oja Tuntun market in Ilorin, the capital of Kwara State. The victim was allegedly attacked at his home in Ilorin's Alubarika, Gaa-Osibi, and Alagbado areas. According to the findings, the incident happened on Thursday night, September, when the victim was attacked with a machete by his assailants, who also kidnapped two of his children.

### KIDNAPPING

- Unknown gunmen have kidnapped the traditional ruler of Owa-Onire in Kwara State's Kwara South Senatorial District. According to reports, he was kidnapped along with his wife and driver. On Saturday, the State Police Public Relations Officer confirmed the report. He revealed that the monarch's wife had been rescued, and that efforts were underway to save the two remaining victims.

### SHOOTING

- In the North-East, troops from Operation Hadin Kai killed an unspecified number of Boko Haram (BH) terrorists and rescued another Chibok schoolgirl who gave birth to twins while in captivity. The troops accomplished the feat on September 29, 2022, after storming the enclave of the Jam'at Ahl as-Sunnah lid-Da'wah wa'l-Jihd terrorist group in the Bula Dawo axis of Borno State's Bama local government area. According to an intelligence report obtained from top military sources, a Counterinsurgency Expert and Security Analyst in Lake Chad, the troops engaged and overwhelmed the insurgents, neutralizing scores of them while several others escaped with fatal gunshot wounds.

### GUNMEN

- The Nigerian Army has revealed that the gunmen terrorizing residents of the South-East geopolitical zone are hiding behind the guise of Biafran agitation in order to commit crimes in the region. The new General Officer Commanding (GOC) of the Nigerian Army's 82 Division, Enugu, stated this over the weekend while visiting Anambra State Governor at the Government House in Awka.

### INSECURITY

- The Federal Capital Territory Administration (FCTA) yesterday removed scavengers known as babanbolas from the Katampe colony in Abuja due to the threat they posed to the FCT. The scavengers, according to the Senior Special Assistant on Monitoring, Inspection, and Enforcement to the Minister of FCT, are dangerous people who are heavily involved in crime. He claimed that residents, including some diplomats, had been complaining about the scavengers' drug use and the security risk they posed to the community.


### MOB ACTION

- A mob lynched and burned two herders apprehended by security agencies in Kaduna State's Birnin Gwari Local Government Area. According to reports, the victims were apprehended based on unsubstantiated claims that they were involved in banditry. According to reports, the mob then lynched and burned the two people. The State Governor had condemned the killing of the herders, according to the Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs, who confirmed the incident in a statement on Sunday.

### BOAT MISHAP

- In Gwamtamu village in Taraba State's Gassol Local Government Area, 14 farmers are said to have died in a boat accident, while many others are still missing. When the incident occurred, the farmers were said to be trying to harvest their crops from flooded farmland. The farmers, who were inside 12 canoes paddling around to harvest their maize, were submerged by water when the canoes capsized due to heavy rain and strong winds.




